What is it?

The Advice Pavilion is a large wooden structure displaying life advice gathered from residents and communities local to or related to the location of its installation. Each one is made for the site of installation.

The Advice Pavilion was created to celebrate the wisdom available in our immediate communities.

Previous installations

The Advice Pavilion began life as part of Art Week Exeter 2018, and was installed in Queen's Crescent Garden, Exeter. It displayed life advice collected from local residents and communities including St. Sidwell's Community Centre, Exeter Central Mosque, St. Sidwell's C.E. Primary School and CoLab Community Centre.

The Advice Pavilion in Queen's Crescent Garden was made with support and from the University Of Exeter, Devon County Council, Art Week Exeter, Kaleider, and Exeter City Council.

This version was a prototype.



How it might work in your space

Each advice pavilion can be custom made for the space it will inhabit, at larger sizes, it can also act as a space to sit in. It can be made from a variety of materials, and how the advice is displayed can vary e.g. stickers, engraving, stenciling. The above version was made of wood. Fees may be sourced from third parties such as local councils. How local communities, and communities engaged with the venue are given opportunity to be involved can be led by Hugh through liason with appropriate staff.
